### **CODE OF CONDUCT**



#### **AS A PLAYER IN BANDON AFC, I AGREE TO:**

- Play fairly, do my best and have fun.
- Be on my best behaviour at all times.
- Abide by all club rules.
- Have high standards of Fair Play.
- Follow the equal status act 2000-2008 to protect against discrimination on 9 specific grounds – Gender, Family Status, Civil Status, Sexual Orientation, Religion, Age, Disability, Race and Traveller Community.
- Respect my teammates and my Managers/Coaches.
- Respect opponents and match officials.
- Shake hands after the match, regardless of the result.
- Be modest in victory and be gracious in defeat.
- Approach the club Children’s Officer with any questions or concerns I might have.

#### **AS A PLAYER IN BANDON AFC, I WILL NOT:**

- Cheat.
- Use abusive language, or argue with, the referee, officials, team mates or opponents.
- Use violence.
- Bully.
- Tell lies about adults or other children.
- Spread rumours.
- Take banned substances to improve performance.
- Keep secrets about any person who may have caused me or my teammates harm.
- Behave in any manner that may bring the name of Bandon AFC into disrepute.

#### **AS A PARENT OF A PLAYER IN BANDON AFC I AGREE TO:**

- Treat all Managers, Coaches and Officials with respect.
- Respect opponents.
- Respect the Club’s facilities, equipment and grounds.
- Respect opponent’s facilities and grounds.
- Follow the equal status act 2000-2008 to protect against discrimination on 9 specific grounds – Gender, Family Status, Civil Status, Sexual Orientation, Religion, Age, Disability, Race and Traveller Community.

#### **AS A PARENT OF A PLAYER IN BANDON AFC I WILL NOT:**

- Cheat.
- Use Violence, or bad language.
- Shout at or argue with players, managers or officials.
- Harm opponents or their property.
- Bully or use bullying tactics to gain advantage.
- Make abusive comments about a player or manager on social media.

*NOTE: Any Player or Parent found in breach of the above will be brought before a three person disciplinary committee. Sanctions may follow.*

## **Photography**

Bandon AFC has adopted a policy in relation to the use of images of players on their website, social media pages and in other publications.

Photographers that are approved will upload photographs to our website and social media platforms. They will also send photographs on behalf of the club to other media outlets.

Where possible, we will try to use models or illustrations when promoting an activity or an event.

Parents, professional or amateur photographers and video operators wishing to record an event or practice session should seek permission with the Club's Children's Officer.
